To be delegated by National Coordinator 2/National Events Coordinator
Events:
 - socializing events (x-mas dinner, schneey, summer events)
 - „workshops“
- Jobs:
 - Edit Inside EYP
 - Organise National Conference
 - General Support (jobs from different resorts)





b) Supporting Alumni:

- Space for Alumni during NC (Sat): 10-years dinner, discussion etc.
- Alumni communication:
- Salutation of Alumni in mails, letters etc.
- Facebook group: EYP Switerland
- Date of Nightcaps: 1st Friday of month (with „specials“: barbecue, invite important EYPer, Jassabend)

c) Newspaper

- newsletter every 1 or 2 months
- add comics and fun stuff
- new articles like „what alumni do after eyp?“

b) How Audrey :

General Invitation sent to all schools by NC Coordinator

NC Coordinator updates Board members about the present list of schools attending the NC. In case of a lack of schools/delegations, Board members inquire more schools in their region about the NC.

- General inquiry on whether they received the invitation and need more information on the Session
- Call up teachers who previously attended a NC ad ask about a second attendance
- Inform the students organisation about the Session
- Go to schools and put up a EYP Placard (if not yet done by the school after receiving the general invitation
- Go to the schools and hold short presentation about EYP and the Session (a la Decurtins in Graubünden in 2006, he should have the material)
